SERIOUS ABOUT LEARNING



MOBILE PHONE MISUSE NEGATIVELY AFFECTS THE FOLLOWING RIGHT:

Articles 28 & 29: Every child has the right to an education...education must develop every child's personality, talents and abilities to the full.



MOBILE PHONES:



MUST be switched off, or on aeroplane mode, and placed in the mobile phone box at the start of the lesson.

MUST NOT be used for texting or social media if permission is given to use a mobile phone during the lesson.



MUST remain in the box if you leave the classroom for any reason during the lesson.

MUST NOT be used for filming or taking photographs without permission **AT ANY TIME** as this may be regarded as a breach of a person's rights and an **OFFENCE** by the police.



CONSEQUENCES

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REFUSAL TO PUT PHONE IN BOX

- Your teacher will issue a behaviour alert (demerit).
- Your Year Head will be called.
- You will be accommodated in another room until your Year Head arrives.

FALSELY CLAIM YOU DO NOT HAVE A PHONE WITH YOU



- Your teacher will issue a behaviour alert.
- You will be instructed again to put your phone in the box.
- If you do this on more than one occasion alternative arrangements will be made.

ARRANGEMENTS MADE

Referred to Year Head where one of the following arrangements will be made:

- Phone handed to Year Head/office at start of each day.
- Phone kept at home.
